Fascist liberalism has always attracted the **disaffected**, **discontented**, and **disoriented**. It is easier to express outrage at the victimization of "my group", and reject a life of liberty and happiness, in pursuit of the **subversion** of the **individual Bill of Rights**.

Classic liberalism enjoys living in a state of <u>love</u>, <u>gratitude</u>, and <u>joy</u>, as a direct result of the pursuit of <u>life</u>, <u>liberty</u>, and <u>happiness</u>, under the <u>individual Bill of Rights</u>.

Saul Alinsky's Rules for Radicals

RULE 1: Power is not only what you have, but what the enemy thinks you have.

RULE 2: Never go outside the expertise of your people.

RULE 3: Whenever possible, go outside the expertise of the enemy.

RULE 4: Make the enemy live up to its own book of rules.

RULE 5: Ridicule is man's most potent weapon.

RULE 6: A good tactic is one your people enjoy.

RULE 7: A tactic that drags on too long becomes a drag.

RULE 8: Keep the pressure on. Never let up.

RULE 9: The threat is usually more terrifying than the thing itself.


RULE 10: If you push a negative hard enough, it will push through and become a positive.
